



Party Lace Scarf



This is Knit with...

Yarn	1 x 25g ball of Kidsilk Haze 70% Kid Mohair 30% Silk 210m per 25g ball 38 x 3mm Swarovski crystal bicone beads
Needles	4.5mm straight needles
Size	53" x 6" [135cm x 15cm]

INSTRUCTIONS:

Techniques:

Before casting on for this scarf you will need to string nineteen of the crystals onto the yarn. When you are nearing the end of the scarf the yarn is cut and the other nineteen beads are strung onto the yarn for knitting in on the final row. To prevent a "weak spot" in the scarf it is recommended that the yarn is cut approximately six rows before the end of the scarf so there is no risk of the crystals working themselves loose through day to day wear.

Place bead: Bring yarn to the front of your work, slip the next stitch purlwise, bring one bead up as close to your right hand needle as you can and then bring the yarn to the back of the work again. This leaves a bead sitting nicely against and in front of the slipped stitch.

Pattern:

String 19 crystals onto yarn. Using the cable cast on method, cast on 40 stitches.

Row 1 (Bead Row): (K1, place bead) 19 times, k2.

Row 2 (WS): P.

Row 3: K3, (yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k1) 4 times, k1.

Row 4: P.

Row 5: K2, (yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k1) 4 times, k2.

Repeat rows 2-5 until nearly out of yarn, leaving enough to work 6 more rows (including beading and cast off rows).

Cut yarn and string the remaining 19 beads onto working yarn. Repeat rows 2-5 once more. Work bead row once more.

Cast off all stitches purlwise using a needle one to two sizes larger to ensure a loose cast off row.

Finishing:

Weave in all ends and block lightly.

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
